MINUTES

Meeting was called to order by Chairman Kevin Mulligan at 5:35 p.m.

Brian Casey read the minutes from the previous meeting of July 20, 2009.

Kevin Mulligan began discussion of 06611 and new Police Department systems. He has the authorization to shut down the 06611 system when the new system is operating fully and will notify all residents currently using 06611.

Brian Casey stated that the State of Connecticut has just notified the Town of Trumbull that they will be offering a "Free" communication system.

Kevin Mulligan asked Michael DeVecchio the status of the training records denied by TRDC. Michael DeVecchio stated that they have had meetings with the First Selectman and Mr. Doyle was to get back to EMS by July 1<sup>st</sup>. Currently they are still waiting for a response.

Dave Bogen entered the meeting at 5:40 p.m.

Wayne Szymt stated that they would have a response in a month regarding the training records.

Glenn Byrnes stated that he met with Peter Oliver.

Brian Casey stated that the radio communications issued for the town needs to be addressed.

Kevin Mulligan asked Wayne Szymt their progress on how to be competitive with today's market.

Wayne Szymt responded that they have changed the rates for all their employees as of January, 2009 and that there have not been any automation changes except replacing the data recorder recently.
