MINUTES

Brian Casey read the minutes from the previous meeting of June 15, 2009.

Old Business

Kevin Mulligan stated that the TRDC is in non-compliance with our request for training records and we will readjust the report request and "TRDC will be seeking legal advice at this time".

Brian Casey stated that the police department currently has a Reverse 911 system which they are possibly replacing with a system that has the capability of calling the entire town in 15 minutes and the residents can update their information to this system.

Kevin Mulligan mentioned the 06611 Alert and the K-12 Alert systems and the possibility of blending into one community notification system.

Kevin Mulligan stated that a current status protocol should be submitted to the CEDC of the alert systems.

Old Business

Kevin Mulligan asked Glenn Byrnes if there has been any contact with Peter Oliver.

Glenn Byrnes stated that Peter Oliver will be in Trumbull, Tuesday, July 21, 2009 at the Police Department and Peter Oliver will be scheduling appointments with the other groups thereafter.
