Maintenance Department Outline:

Tashua Glen: Mr. Lund

The Glen has made it through the winter nicely. The tees, greens, and fairways have responded well to the warmer days and rain we received. Some of the recent projects we've completed on the Glen are:

Removing dead trees on the left side of the first tee, as well as cut away the underbrush and pushed back the leaves that had built up along the wood line.

Cleaning up the leaves from the left side of #2 and the back right of #8 in an effort to try and keep those greens as debris free as possible.

Cutting down a large dead tree to the back right of the 6th green.

Tashua Knolls: Mr. Nagashima

Overall Tashua Knolls came out of the winter fine. There appears to be no winter damage on any of the greens. The Bunkers had little washouts and have been repaired.

I am very happy that we finished up our winter projects and opened on March 17. The courses are mostly free of debris, sticks and leaves. To date we have mowed the greens 3 times and are starting to get on a regular mowing pattern as growth allows.

Projects/Follow up:

Tee Project: All of the forward tees have been sodded. All of the surrounds have been sodded. The 8th tee is open and all of the other tees will be open on or around April 1.

The drain on #9 has been sodded.

The sinkhole on 11th green has been repaired.

The dangerous tree on the walk path between 13th and 14th tee has been removed.

A plan is being developed for a potential Kaulbach project to dress up and install some plants next to Miklus Center by the 10th tee.
