1. Application 16-25 Tomasz Miskowiak Permit approval to fix retaining walls, regrade a portion of backyard, remove two dead trees, five leaning trees and plant shrubs and grass within a regulated area at 63 Tashua Road. **Applicant has requested a continuance to February meeting.**

2. Application 16-26 Joseph Sansone Permit approval for area of road & building construction, utility installation and general grading within a regulated area at 110 Fernwood Road. **Public Hearing continued from December 6, 2016 IWWC meeting.**

3. Application 16-27 Oakview Realty Acquisitions LLC & Trumbull Developers LLC Permit approval for site disturbance, grading and construction activities for development of a 202 unit multi-family community within a regulated area at 100 Oakview Drive.

4. Application 16-30 St. Joseph High School, Inc. Permit approval to restore the wetland pond, create new wetland adjacent to existing drainage channel, create flood storage and

runoff detention area. Remove existing house, driveway and walk pavement. Construct new parking and walk pavement within a regulated area at 2320-2340-2328 Huntington Turnpike.

Permit approval for construction of single-family house and driveway, remove trees, build retaining walls and landscape within a regulated area at Parcel D03-188 (Main Street). **Applicant has requested a continuance to February meeting.**
