The Trumbull Water Pollution Control Authority held their monthly meeting on Wednesday, October 22, 2014 at 7:00 p.m. in the Long Hill Room, Town Hall, 5866 Main Street, Trumbull, Connecticut.

Chairman Wright called the October 22, 2014 meeting of the Trumbull WPCA to order at 7:04 pm.

**Executive Session.**

MOTION made Wright seconded Palmieri to move into executive session at 7:05 p.m. to discuss preliminary drafts and/or notes as set forth by C.G.S. 1-210(b)(1), matters concerning public officials or employees per C.G.S. 1-200(6) and/or discuss with the Town Attorney strategy and negotiations with respect to pending litigation as defined by 1-200(6) and/or to discuss attorney client-privileged information as set forth by 1-210 relating to the following:

- Mark IV - Contract 3 and Contract 4
- Regionalization and/or renegotiation of Bridgeport sewer treatment contract
- Assessment - 72 Old Dike Road

Remaining in the executive session will be commissioners Jeffrey Wright, Fred Palmieri, John Gray, Timothy Hampford, Paul Whetstone, Frank Smeriglio, Attorney Dennis Kokenos, Christine Kurtz and John Marsilio. No discussion. MOTION CARRIED UNANIMIOUSLY.

**6. Executive Session**

At 7:05 pm, the tape recorder was turned off, the clerk left the room and the Commission went into executive session.

At 8:26 pm, the clerk was called back into the room and the recorder was turned on.

MOTION made Wright seconded Hampford to close executive session at 8:26 pm and to state for the record that no vote was taken. No discussion. MOTION CARRIED UNANIMOUSLY.

MOTION made Hampford, seconded Wright to allow Palmieri, on behalf of the WPCA Commission to execute a consulting contract negotiated by Town Attorney for exploratory work related to development of regional

authority with the City of Bridgeport. Discussion followed regarding mediation with Bridgeport in Superior Court. Limited time frame to report back to the court regarding the development of a potential region. For the Commission to make an informed decision, need to obtain consulting services to form a potential rate model for our region. Anticipated that we will receive a contract for said consultants prior to next meeting, it is imperative that we procure consultant as quickly as possible to report back to the court in a timely manner, necessitating someone from the Commission to have authority to enter into said contract once it is negotiated with the Town Attorney. Following discussion, MOTION CARRIED UNANIMOUSLY.

**1. Minutes to previous meetings.**

MOTION made Palmieri, seconded Gray to approve the minutes of the September 24, 2014 as presented. No discussion. Hampford abstained, MOTION CARRIED.

**4. Old Business.**

**6448 Main Street - Cooling Tower Discussion.**

Chairman Wright recognized Dennis Cleary, consultant for St Joseph's Manor. Frank Smeriglio provided background relative to cooling tower evaporation issue at St. Joseph's Manor. Mr. Cleary indicated that some towns allow businesses to purchase and install exception meters, metering water usage for such systems that utilize water at the intake but that does not ultimately go through the sewer system, subtracting said water from the sewer usage charge. Frank explained that Bridgeport would also have to approve the system as the Aquarion figures are given to Bridgeport for their determination of our sewer use charges. Mr. Cleary indicated that he requested from Bridgeport what their regulations are, and has not heard back. Frank recommended presenting the proposal to Bridgeport and if they approve it, we would revisit it. Attorney Kokenos recommended a letter to Bridgeport to determine their position.

Mr. Cleary also is requesting a refund of WPCA charges for which Aquarion meter had been erroneously billing for water. Aquarion has credited St. Joseph's Manor a substantial sum for 4 years of billing error. The Commission believes we can only provide credit for the current year as our payments have been made to Bridgeport WPCA for previous years. Attorney Kokenos will reach out to Bridgeport to determine their position. Mr. Palmieri asked if it was relative to the Nursing Home only, Mr. Cleary indicated that it was.

**3. Wright-Pierce Update.**

Phase 3 and I/I Study. Christine Kurtz indicated that she is working with Frank on getting design recommendations into the current design project (I/I Study), the implementation of rehab recommendations from Phase 2 and trying to get Phase 3 in the same contract.

Phase 4. Preparing draft of SSES Evaluation for the Phase 4 siting area. Frank reiterated that Phase 2, 3 and 4 are different areas of Trumbull that are being investigated to see if there is infiltration in the pipes that produce flow going in to Bridgeport. They are concentrating on the Beardsley side of town.

**2. Contract 4.**

Progress report: Frank Smeriglio reported since the last meeting:

Easement restoration: He sent correspondence to the property owner of the remaining easement to be restored and is awaiting word back.

Ejector pumps: He has not heard back from the contractor and there was no response to his letter of July 22, 2014. Town Attorney to draft an additional letter.

**5. New Business.**



Dear Mr. Sliva,

We spoke week before last about the possibility that new homeowners on my property will have to hook up to the sewer line. We spoke about you and Bill Maurer coming to the property to discuss options.

I spoke to Frank Smeriglio yesterday and he suggested writing you this letter to request being put on the schedule for your next meeting on November 12th. I qualified for an extension for the sewer hook up because my septic tank met the requirements in being less than 15 years old. I would like to request an extension for the new owner as the installation of over 300 hundred feet of sewer line would have to be run directly through wetlands which in itself would be very disruptive to the wetlands, it would also most likely involve the removal of large trees.

The driveway would incline toward the sewer, thus not making gravity and a pump would most likely be required, adding to the expense of 300+ feet of sewer line and tree removal. The sewer line in Booth Hill Road is also directly in the center of my driveway, if the sewer was required to be hooked up in the center, that would also require my driveway to be broken up, that in itself would be a \$15,000+ to replace the driveway.


I have not been able to get concrete estimates because the three sewer companies that have looked at it have said the Town would have to draw up a plan, but I have gotten a ball park quote with the best scenario of about \$20,000. This does not include a pump, about \$5,000, cutting down of trees or replacing my driveway, which could drive the installation upwards of \$40,000 or more.

The normal customary cost to most Trumbull residents is \$2,500-\$5,000 to hook up to the sewer. If the town required this property to hook up, it would cause a significant hardship to the owner as well as damage delicate wetlands. It would also be a significant hardship to us as it could preclude us from selling the house as we also don't have the money for this additional expense. In addition, when we bought this house new in 1996, we were not told of plans of sewers eventually coming into this neighborhood, had we known, we may not have bought the house.


I have enclosed photos of the property to give you an idea of the scale of this undertaking. I look forward to meeting you and discussing this further with you.




This is standing where

the yard.




This is about half the length  
of the 300+ feet.




Stream runs under
