Motion was made by Commissioner Portanova that the Town of Trumbull and the Trumbull Police Department hire Kaitlyn Arcamone subject to the medical testing and drug testing. Miss Arcamone will not need to proceed with the psychological as she has already been tested. Motion made first by Commissioner Portanova, seconded by Commissioner Zamary. There was no further discussion. ALL IN FAVOR, motion carried unanimously.

Commissioner Portanova asked that the record reflect the date of hire for Mr. Grimaldi and Miss Arcamone will be determined at the discretion of Chief Lombardo.

There being no further business to discuss, and upon motion made by Commissioner Magliocco to adjourn meeting, seconded by Commissioner Vazzano, the Trumbull Police Commission adjourned by unanimous consent at 6:43 p.m.
