

MINUTES OF MEETING OF
TRUMBULL ETHICS COMMISSION
JUNE 19, 2014

Present were Attorney Thomas E. Lee, Chairman, Attorney James Stapleton, Attorney Martin McCann, Attorney William Brown, Mr. Robert Miller, Pastor Joseph Piccirillo. Absent was Attorney Eric Gross, Vice Chairman.

The meeting opened at 7:05 p.m. A motion was made to approve the Minutes of the meetings of May 9 and May 12, 2014, which was seconded and approved unanimously.

The Chairman indicated that Ms. Jamie Bratt, an employee of the Town in the Planning and Zoning Department, had made an inquiry to him and sought the assistance of the Commission to explore her inquiry. This was approved by the Commission.

At 7:15 p.m., Chairman Lee recused himself and left the room.

At 7:16 p.m., a motion was made by Attorney Brown, and seconded by Mr. Miller, to move into executive session, pursuant to Section 1-200(6)(A) of the C.G.S., concerning a discussion of the performance of an individual as contained in Complaint #2-2014.

At 7:28 p.m., the Commission moved out of executive session and a motion was made, and seconded, to dismiss Complaint #2-2014 for a lack of probable cause. The decision was unanimous.

Chairman Lee returned to the room.

At 7:35 p.m., a motion was made, seconded and unanimously passed, and the Commission moved into executive session to consider Complaints #3-2014 and #4 -2014, pursuant to Section 1-200(6)(A) of the C.G.S., because the matter concerned the performance of a public officer or employee. The Commission came out of executive session at 8:25 p.m. and a motion was made by Attorney McCann, and seconded by Pastor Piccirillo, to dismiss Complaints #3-2014 and #4-2014 for lack of jurisdiction in that the acts complained of were not made in the respondent's capacity as a Town Official or Town Employee. The motion was passed unanimously.

At 8:28, a motion was made to adjourn the meeting, seconded and unanimously approved.
