1. Scout must be ten years of age by March 28th, 2012.
2. Scout must submit an essay on why they would like to serve in the chosen job.
 - * Essays should be handwritten, neat and at least one paragraph long. Content is important, so find out about the duties of the job.

 - * Essays must be received by Tuesday, March 14th 2012 to be considered for selection.
 - * Essays will be judged on content, neatness and girl effort.
 - * Each essay should list a second and third choice of job (no essay is necessary for these jobs)
3. Scout must wear a uniform to Government Day.
4. Scout must bring a signed permission slip to Government Day.
5. Scout must arrange transportation to Town Hall at 8:45 am and pickup from the Town Hall at 1:00 pm (following lunch and closing ceremony)
