

Enter the Trumbull Conservation Commission's Winter Photo Contest

What: A contest among great Trumbull-based photos in the following categories:

Trumbull, a Winter Wonderland – Photos of Trumbull landmarks, landscape, etc... in Winter

Trumbullites in Winter – Photos of Residents at work or play

Trumbull Wildlife in Winter– The birds, mammals or other critters of Trumbull in Winter.

Who: Open to all Trumbull Residents (except Commission Members.)

When: Deadline for Submissions is Valentine's Day, February 14, 2014.

Where: Digital photos should be emailed to Conservation@trumbull-ct.gov. Each photographer can submit two (2) entries in each of the three (3) categories (i.e., 6-photos maximum per photographer.) The preferred format is .jpeg.

Only digital photos, no hard copy photos will be accepted. On your honor, photos must be taken within the Town of Trumbull. With each photo please provide the following:

- 1-a description of the photo (e.g., sleigh riding in Twin Brook Park),
- 2-the specific category (e.g., Trumbull, People or Wildlife)
- 3-the date the photo was taken & photographer's name.

Why: Because we live in a beautiful Town and it's fun to take and share great pictures with our neighbors.

Contest Rules

- All entries become the property of the Town of Trumbull Conservation Commission, with shared rights for unlimited reproduction in print, electronic publications and promotional materials (e.g., Conservation Commission webpage and FaceBook page) for an unlimited period of time. If you have a photo you wish retain a copyright on, don't submit it for this for fun, amateur photography contest. Photo credit will be given whenever possible.
- Entries can be submitted in either color or black and white, (jpeg. format preferred.)
- The Conservation Commission assumes the photographer has the consent of any person or business that appears in a photograph.
- The Conservation Commission members will judge the contest and all decisions by the judges are final.

Winners

Judges will select a first place winning photo for each of the contest categories. Winners will be notified by email. The Conservation Commission will issue a press release and winning tchotchke (e.g., trophy, ribbon, certificate). Sorry...there is no cash prize.
