# CT STATE LEGISLATURE APPROVES LAND SWAP BETWEEN TRUMBULL AND BRIDGEPORT

TRUMBULL - - First Selectman Timothy M. Herbst announced today that members of the Senate and House of the Connecticut Legislature have unanimously approved emergency legislation that changes the municipal boundaries of the Town of Trumbull and the City of Bridgeport.

The Fairchild Wheeler parcel, the proposed site for a Regional Multi-Magnet School, will now be located within the boundaries of the City of Bridgeport. The bill awaits Governor Dannel P. Malloy's signature. The First Selectman would like to thank Representative T.R. Rowe and House Minority Leader Larry Cafero for including language in the legislation that will allow the Town of Trumbull to negotiate with the State of Connecticut on the future use and ownership of an 18+ acre parcel of State owned land located on Quarry Road.

The First Selectman would also like to thank all members of the legislature, Chief Counsel to the Governor, Andrew McDonald, Acting Commissioner of the Department of Education, George Coleman and Governor Dannel P. Malloy for all their efforts in facilitating this boundary change.

The Town of Trumbull, the City of Bridgeport and municipalities in the region will benefit from the legislative act approved today.
