VEHICLE STOP LEADS TO DRUG AND WEAPON CHARGES FOR TRUMBULL MAN

On October 31, 2017 at 2:00 a.m., a Trumbull officer on patrol conducted a vehicle stop and smelled marijuana, a search of the car revealed narcotics and weapons and the driver was arrested.

During motor vehicle stop on Main Street for a license plate violation and driving an unregistered car, an Officer smelled an odor of marijuana coming from the car. The driver was identified as Mark Sicilian age 26, of Walnut Avenue, Trumbull. The officer had Sicilian exit his car and Sicilian informed the officer he was in possession of a pistol.

Officer's secured the weapon and searched the car based on the strong odor. Officers discovered a baggie containing marijuana, 35 folds of heroin, a drug pipe, several prescription pills and an illegal knife in the car and additional pills on Mr. Sicilian himself.

Upon further investigation, it was discovered Mr. Sicilian did possess a valid CT pistol permit but the pistol was registered to his deceased brother.

Mark Sicilian was issued a warning for the motor vehicle violations and was charged with:

- Possession of Narcotics with Intent to Sell,
- Possession of a Controlled Substance,
- Weapons in Motor Vehicle,
- Failure to Transfer Registration of Firearm,
- Possession of Marijuana and
- Possession of Drug Paraphernalia.

Sicilian on was held on a \$2500 bond for court on November 7, 2017.
