WARRANT SERVED ON MAN FOR ASSAULTING GIRLFRIEND

On November 2, 2017, Trumbull Police served Richard Salazar, age 36, last known address of Richards Avenue, Norwalk with an arrest warrant for several family violence charges stemming from a violent assault on his girlfriend, Halloween night.

On October 31, 2017, Trumbull police met with the victim at a relative's home in town. The victim told police that Salazar had been there with her earlier. The woman had visible cuts and bruises on her face and she told officers that she and Salazar were at the home for Halloween and Salazar was drinking heavily. Salazar began to accuse her of sleeping with other men and began the assault by throwing her across the room, Salazar then allegedly struck her several times in the face with his fists and his cellular phone as she attempted get away from him. At one point the victim tried to hide in a closet but Salazar opened the door and continued hitting her until she was able to safely lock herself in a bathroom, at which point Salazar left the home. The victim declined medical attention.

Trumbull Police, assisted by other departments began checking known addresses for Salazar but were unable to locate Salazar that night. A Felony arrest warrant was obtained for Salazar and he was charged with:

Unlawful Restraint in the First Degree,
Assault in the Second Degree and
Disorderly Conduct.

On November 2, 2017, Richard Salazar turned himself in to police. He was processed and released after posting a court set bond of \$50,000, for a court date of November 3, 2017.
