TWO YEAR OLD CHILD FALLS FROM WINDOW

On April 12, 2017, Trumbull Emergency Services responded to a residence where a two-year old male had fallen from a second floor window but survived with un-specified injuries. The child was transported to Bridgeport Hospital; the fall was determined to be an accident.

At 6:28 p.m., Trumbull Police Officers and Trumbull Emergency Medical Services responded to a residence in the Woodland Hills Condominiums, located on Woodland Hills Drive after a 911 call was received from the child's mother. Officers found the child in the driveway, conscious and crying with his mother. The first responding officers reported that the child had what appeared to be non-life threatening injuries and he was treated and transported to Bridgeport Hospital by Trumbull EMS.

Trumbull Police determined the child had been sitting on a couch in the living room with his mother in their home. A nearby window behind where the child was sitting was open but had a screen in place. When the child's mother looked away for a moment and the child apparently stood up and pressed on the screen which gave way. The child fell to the pavement 15-20 feet below. All preliminary information indicated the fall was accidental, therefore no criminal charges were filed.
