THEFT FROM MOTOR VEHICLE ARRESTS

EARLY FRIDAY MORNING, JUNE 30, 2017, AT ABOUT 3:04 A.M., A TRUMBULL POLICE OFFICER SPOTTED A VEHICLE TRAVELING SLOWLY ON BREWSTER PLACE WITH NO HEADLIGHTS ON. THE VEHICLE WAS STOPPED AND THE TWO OCCUPANTS INDICATED THAT THEY WERE AT A FRIENDS HOUSE WHO LIVED NEARBY. FURTHER INVESTIGATION BY OFFICERS FOUND THAT THE OCCUPANTS HAD STOLEN ITEMS FROM FOUR UNLOCKED VEHICLES THAT WERE PARKED AT HOMES IN THE AREA. THEFTS FROM THESE VEHICLES INCLUDED A LAPTOP COMPUTER, CREDIT CARDS AND A WALLET BELONGING TO AREA RESIDENTS. RENELL CAMBELL AGE 19 OF 721 PLATT STREET, BRIDGEPORT, CT. AND MARCUS NEGRON AGE 18 OF 121 WILCOX STREET BRIDGEPORT, CT. WERE ARRESTED. CHARGES INCLUDED BURGLARY, LARCENY, AND POSSESSION OF BURGLAR TOOLS. THEY WERE TRANSPORTED TO SUPERIOR COURT IN BRIDGEPORT FOR ARRAINMENT THIS MORNING.
