WATERBURY MAN ARRESTED AFTER BREAKING INTO WIFE'S HOME

On July 9, 2017, Trumbull Police responded to a Stonehouse Road residence and arrested a woman's estranged husband after he broke into the house while the family was sleeping.

Jamell Nelson, age 35, of 32 Young Street, Waterbury, was charged with 1st Degree Burglary, Disorderly Conduct, Criminal Mischief, Interfering with Police and Refusal to be Fingerprinted after he was uncooperative during booking.

At 12:30 a.m. Trumbull police received a frantic 911 call from Nelson's wife after she and her children were startled from their sleep by a noise and found Nelson in their kitchen. Nelson apparently climbed up onto a roof and broke into the home through a window. Nelson exited the home when he heard his wife calling police and his children crying. An arriving officer found Nelson on the front porch of the home and took him into custody. Police learned that the woman had been separated from Nelson for over a year, which prompted her move to Trumbull. Nelson was held on \$100,000 Bond for court on July 10.
