TRUMBULL TEEN ROBBED AT GUN POINT

On Monday, October 9<sup>th</sup>, at about 9:00 p.m., a local teen was attacked and robbed, when he and his friend met up with another teenaged acquaintance in a secluded area along Canoe Brook Lake. A second Trumbull teen was later charged for his part in the robbery.

The group of teens had gathered together, planning to socialize and smoke marijuana. When they met their associate friend, who had already parked in the area, an unidentified male got out of the friend's car and into the back seat of the victim's car. He then held a gun to the victim's head and ordered him and his friend out of their car. As they exited, three to four other males exited the associate's car. The victim was ordered to the ground and was robbed of his wallet, phone and money as he was kicked repeatedly in the face and head. The victim's friend also had his phone taken from him before the attackers fled the scene in the associate's vehicle. The victim was later treated for minor injuries.

The victim and his friend subsequently identified the associate friend, who was arrested a short time later at his home in Trumbull. The seventeen-year-old male was charged with Robbery 1<sup>st</sup>, Assault 3<sup>rd</sup> and Larceny 5<sup>th</sup> Degree, and was released to the custody of his parents. He is scheduled to appear in Juvenile court on October 18<sup>th</sup>.

The police are continuing their investigation to identify the other parties who were involved in the robbery and assault.
