TIP LEADS POLICE TO LARGE HOUSE PARTY; RESIDENT ARRESTED

On November 19, 2017 shortly after midnight, Trumbull Police received a report of a large gathering via our internet tip website. Officers went to the home located at 215 White Plains Road and confirmed that there was a large gathering where persons under age 21 had been consuming alcohol. Police arrested Konrad Nevers age 21, who's actual address is listed as 1324 Newgate Road, Suffield, CT, for violation of Connecticut's "Hosting Law" which makes it illegal for anyone in control of a residence to permit minors to consume alcohol on the premises.

When officers arrived at the home after receiving the tip information, they found up to 70 young people in and around the home who began to flee. Police made contact with numerous minors and most identified themselves as students at Sacred Heart University. Police stood by as the attendees all arranged for rides. Konrad Nevers told police he lives at the home and was identified as being related to the owners of the home. Police located evidence of a drinking party inside the residence. Nevers was summonsed to appear on November 28, at Bridgeport Superior Court. Trumbull Police will additionally follow up with this incident by notifying the University the party guests and/or host attends and the homeowner.
