FORMER RESIDENT TO FACE CHARGES FOR COURT ORDER VIOLATIONS

Trumbull Police charged a former resident with several counts of Violation of a Protective Order after he contacted a family member via electronic communication.

On February 5, 2018, Raymond Genet 49, of Cranston RI, was issued a full no contact order from the court stating he have no contact, of any kind, with his ex-wife and family.

Genet ignored the order and used various forms of electronic communications to contact his family throughout the summer from June through August. A warrant was issued for his arrest and Genet was taken into custody by Rhode Island officials after being notified by the Trumbull Police department.

Genet also had two outstanding warrants from previous arrests involving the Trumbull Police.

He was subsequently extradited back to Trumbull on Wednesday September 19th, where he was charged with 23 counts of Violation of a Protective Order and 2 counts of Failure to Appear. He was held on \$111,000.00 bond and is scheduled to appear in court on September 26, 2018.
