1. RESOLUTION TC29-78: To consider and act upon a resolution which would appoint Richard Bolton as a member of the Equity, Diversity and Inclusion Task Force for a term extending to the first Monday of December 2024. (Johnson)

1. RESOLUTION TC29-78: BE IT RESOLVED, That Richard Bolton, be and the same is hereby appointed as a member of the Equity, Diversity and Inclusion Task Force for a term extending to the first Monday of December 2024.
2. RESOLUTION TC29-79: BE IT RESOLVED, That the appointment by the First Selectman of Regina Evans, be and the same is hereby approved as a member of the Golf Course Commission for a term extending to the first Monday of December 2023.
3. RESOLUTION TC29-83: BE IT RESOLVED, That Resolution TC27-89 as adopted on August 6, 2018, and as amended by TC27-187 on September 5, 2019 and as further amended by TC28-9 on January 6, 2020, and as further amended by TC28-128 on December 7, 2020, is hereby repealed and the following substituted in its place:

BE IT RESOLVED, That the Community Facilities Building Committee is hereby formed to develop options to create up-to-date, useful, and cost-effective spaces for a Senior and Community Center to better serve the community. The committee shall consider the use of potential new construction and Town-owned properties as locations for said Senior and Community Center; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, That the membership shall consist of two (2) Town Council representatives, provided that such members shall not be from the same political party, and eight (8) electors of the Town of Trumbull. All persons previously appointed and presently serving as members of said committee shall continue to serve.
