### MINUTES

The Special Trumbull Police Pension Board of Trustees meeting was called to order via virtual at 5:32 p.m.

#### ***QDRO – George Florida and Lisa Florida***

Sgt. Robert Coppola indicated that the Police Pension Board received a letter from the Law Office of Elizabeth L. McMahon regarding the QDRO for Sgt. George Florida and Lisa Florida, which has been finalized by the Court. The letter was forwarded to the Actuary, Brad Fisher of Findley for his review and to provide pension calculations. The Board needs to provide the letter from Attorney McMahon to both parties within four weeks of receipt of letter. The alternate payee, the ex-spouse of Sgt. Florida will receive a 33.33% accrued benefit once Sgt. Florida retires. The figures were calculated by Findley and his staff, which is listed under Exhibit A. The figures were calculated from the date of their divorce, which is the Determination Date, October 26, 2005. The benefits that were calculated on Exhibit A are based on the figures that were provided to the Actuary. Sgt. Coppola went into further detail on how the calculations were determined. The amount of benefit that will be awarded to the alternate payee will be \$623.60 when Sgt. Florida retires. It was confirmed with Mr. Fisher that

once Sgt. Florida retires his benefit calculations would be re-calculated. The \$623.60 the alternate payee receives will remain the same amount when Sgt. Florida retires. Sgt. Coppola indicated that it is the Boards duty to accept the QDRO from the Court and send a copy of confirmation to Sgt. George Florida and Lisa Florida.

A motion was made by Sgt. Coppola to accept the QDRO as presented by the Court along with Exhibit A regarding Sgt. George Florida and Lisa Florida as determined by Findley the funds Actuary, seconded by Chief Lombardo. There was no further discussion. Motion passed unanimously.

***Adjournment***

There being no further business to discuss and upon motion made by Commissioner Trefz and seconded by Chief Lombardo the Special Trumbull Police Pension Board adjourned by unanimous consent at 5:39 p.m.
