Quarterly Report Update from Michael Quirini, Principal

New Business

Approval of Pension Calculations from USI for Deputy Chief Leonard Scinto

A motion was made by Trustee Allen to approve the monthly retirement benefit of Deputy Chief Leonard Scinto based on the calculations provided to the Board by the Fund's actuary, Brad Fisher of USI, in the monthly benefit of \$8,794.56 payable beginning June 1, 2022, seconded by Trustee Perez. There was no further discussion. Motion carried unanimously.

A motion was made by Trustee Allen to approve the one-time in-month retirement benefit for Deputy Chief Leonard Scinto based on the calculations provided to this Board by the Fund's actuary, Brad Fisher of USI in the amount of \$4,822.94, which represents the portion of his benefit payable for the period of May 15, 2022 through May 31, 2022, seconded by Trustee Perez. There was no further discussion. Motion carried unanimously.
