MINUTES

The Trumbull Police Pension Fund Board of Trustees meeting was called to order at 5:45 p.m.

Chairman Baldwin commented it is great to see everyone in person.

Chairman Baldwin formally welcomed Trustees/Commissioners Mary Beth Thornton and Kathleen Champion.

Approval of May 11, 2021 Trumbull Police Pension Board Minutes

Motion made by Trustee Allen to approve the May 11, 2021 Police Pension Board minutes, seconded by Trustee Lombardo. There was no further discussion. Motion passed with two abstentions, Trustees Coppola and Magliocco.

Approval of Retiree Pension Adjustments – Escalator Increase – Effective July 1, 2021 to June 30, 2022

Chairman Baldwin indicated that the trustees received the spreadsheets with the calculations. Chairman Baldwin explained that any increases the Trumbull Police Union receives the retirees receive one-half of the increase as part of the contractual agreement.

Chairman Baldwin asked if there were any questions.

Trustee Magliocco asked why some of the retiree's increases show zero percent (0%).

Chairman Baldwin went on to explain for his increase, he was in the reserve and did not have enough time to retire. Therefore his pension is a set rate. Chairman Baldwin is not entitled to the escalator increases as the other retirees.

Trustee Magliocco asked about retiree Chief Ambrosini's increase.

Chief Lombardo explained retiree Chief Ambrosini did not receive an increase because he has not received his yet. Once Chief Lombardo does receive his so will the other retired Chiefs.

Trustee Coppola explained there are other retirees that do not receive an escalator increase as Chairman Baldwin explained, it is due to them not having enough years of service to receive the yearly increases.

Trustee Coppola also explained there are payments of only twenty-five (25%) to a surviving spouse when a retiree passes away. The surviving spouse receives half of what the retiree received which would be twenty-five percent (25%), i.e. Rosemary Dobosz, she is a surviving spouse.

Trustee Coppola made a motion to approve the retiree pension escalator increase effective July 1, 2021 to June 30, 2022, as reviewed and confirmed by Findley (Actuary), seconded by Trustee Perez. There was no further discussion. Motion passed unanimously.

Adjournment

There being no further business to discuss and upon motion made by Trustee Magliocco and seconded by Trustee Coppola the Trumbull Police Pension Board adjourned by unanimous consent at 5:51 p.m.
