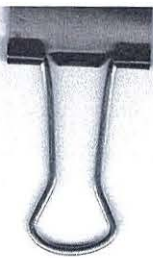

To create routing efficiencies throughout our customer base in the Town of Trumbull, All American Waste would like to declare the following regarding our RFQ:

Regarding the contractor being exempt for all tipping fees related to the disposal of all solid wastes from the Town buildings & BOE, All American Waste requests an annual tonnage credit at the Trumbull Transfer Station as presently exists at 800 tons. All American Waste will be charged tipping fees for all tonnage delivered to the Transfer Station (including tipping fees not previously charged under the agreement). Tonnage credits allocated for the Town buildings & BOE will offset those same charges. All American Waste guarantees delivery of tonnage in excess of those credits.

Regarding the term of agreement, All American Waste will extend the same pricing terms as outlined in the RFQ for a length of ten (10) years.

All American Waste LLC is committed to operating the most environmentally friendly trucks in Connecticut. Our entire fleet of diesel burning trucks is in the process of being replaced by clean fuel CNG (compressed natural gas) powered refuse and recycling vehicles.

If awarded this work, All American Waste LLC intends to continue to service the Town of Trumbull's contract with CNG vehicles.




