

Trumbull Town Council

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that at a meeting of the Trumbull Town Council held on August 5, 2024, the following legislation was adopted:

1. RESOLUTION TC30-70: BE IT RESOLVED, That the Trumbull Town Council authorizes Vicki A. Tesoro, First Selectman, as the individual authorized to submit the Coronavirus State and Local Fiscal Recovery Funds (SLFRF), part of the American Rescue Plan Act (ARPA), grant application for the Community Gardens Project, and to sign all subsequent contracts, amendments, reports, and related documents in order to administer and implement the project.
2. RESOLUTION TC30-71: BE IT RESOLVED, That the Trumbull Town Council authorizes the submission of the funding application for the Emergency Operation Center, Command Trailer Improvements and Training, under the Emergency Management Performance Grant Pool Fund, and identifies Vicki A. Tesoro, First Selectman, as the individual authorized to sign the application and all subsequent amendments, reports, and related documents in order to administer and implement the project.
3. RESOLUTION TC30-66: BE IT RESOLVED, That a certain five-year lease between Trumbull Center, LLC, as Landlord, and the Town of Trumbull, as Tenant, for the premises described as the following: Unit 10, approximately 1600 sq feet, 2nd Floor, 2 Daniels Farm Rd, Trumbull, CT is hereby approved; and BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that Vicki A. Tesoro, First Selectman, is authorized to execute the lease on behalf of the Town; and BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that as a condition of this approval the Board of Education shall assume the responsibility of making all rental payments provided for in said lease.
4. RESOLUTION TC30-72: BE IT RESOLVED, That \$40,000 is hereby appropriated from the Fund Balance to 01014200-522202 P&Z-Professional Services.
5. RESOLUTION TC30-73: BE IT RESOLVED, That \$38,000 is hereby appropriated from the Fund Balance to 01010000-522202 Town Council-Professional Services.
6. RESOLUTION TC30-74: BE IT RESOLVED, That in accordance with Section 7-100k of the Connecticut General Statutes, and notwithstanding the language of Chapter III, Section 6(C) of the Charter of the Town of Trumbull, the First Selectman is hereby empowered to appoint a Tax Assessor without a fixed term, not to exceed four (4) years.
7. RESOLUTION TC30- 75: BE IT RESOLVED, That the resolution entitled “Resolution Appropriating \$142,375,000 For The Planning, Design, Demolition, Construction, Renovation, Equipping And Furnishing Of A New Hillcrest Middle School And Authorizing The Issuance Of \$142,375,000 Bonds Of The Town To Meet Said Appropriation And Pending The Issuance Thereof The Making Of Temporary Borrowings For Such Purpose”, adopted by the Town Council on July 1, 2024, be submitted to the Town electors for approval or disapproval at a referendum in conjunction with the general election to be held on Tuesday, November 5, 2024, between the hours of

6:00 a.m. and 8:00 p.m. (E.T.), and that the warning of said referendum shall state the question to be voted upon.

8. RESOLUTIONTC 30-76: BE IT RESOLVED, That the Town Clerk of Trumbull is directed to prepare explanatory text for the Hillcrest Middle School Referendum question, with the approval of the Town Attorney in consultation with the bond counsel and the Council Chairman.
